A. BLG partners with health care providers to increase their profitability and reduce their A/R through consulting, legal, and administrative work.



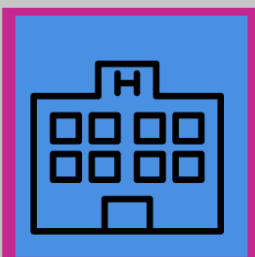
Q. What are your practice areas?
